XXX, aged 27, is from XXX at XXX. His level of education is Grade 11. He said he is staying with his brother who has a business of Tiling and Roofing. There is also his uncle and his older sister who stays with them as well.

Mr XXX responded very well to the program. He showed great skills in Colour Dialogue. His shapes and colors showed that he's a skillful person. He shared with others the challenges of not having parents around. He also spoke about his drug addiction, and how he's unable to control his temper when he has conflict with others. Through the Addiction and Dealing with Conflict session, he said he learned that there are assertive ways of handling conflict.

Mr XXX said the victim of his offence was his uncle. He said there was a family gathering, and they were drinking. There was a misunderstanding and exchange of words, and they fought. He said his hand was swollen, and after a week, his hand was still swollen and that weekend he went to the bar and drank and went home and started a fight with his uncle in which he stabbed his uncle. He received a sentence of 5yrs. This is his second conviction.

He said he's very sorry for what he has done. Even though he apologized before he was sentenced, he said he needs assistance to see his uncle again and tell him how terribly he feels about his deeds. He said if his uncle could accept to hear him out, he would like to participate in a family conference.

After prison Mr XXX hopes to join his brother in his XXX and XXX business, He said he would ask him to hire him again as he was helping him before.

This can be achieved if participant changes his behaviour towards his family. It seem as if the family doesn't want to sign for him as he said he troubled them a lot, He still needs help in this regard.
